

FATHERHOOD PROGRAM

The Fatherhood Program developed by founder Glen Warren, has been involved in the empowerment of men for over 25 years. The program is designed and developed for non-custodial fathers who want to come on a volunteer basis or are court ordered who otherwise will go to jail for non-payment of child support.

In order to successfully complete our fatherhood program participants must attend our weekly class offered for 2 hours per class for 12 weeks.

Fathers Forever has been in Wake County Child Support Court since 2010. We continue to work closely with the judges in Wake County Child Support Court and Wake County Child Support Enforcement who willingly refer fathers to our program because of its effectiveness. In addition to referrals from Child Support, we also receive referrals from

- Domestic Violence Court
- Child Protective Services
- Wake County Human Services
- Wake County Reentry Council
- North Carolina Department of Public Safety

Since the inception of the fatherhood program, over 500 men have graduated; 80% with jobs.
